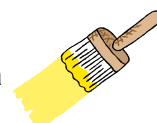

Marriage Encounter

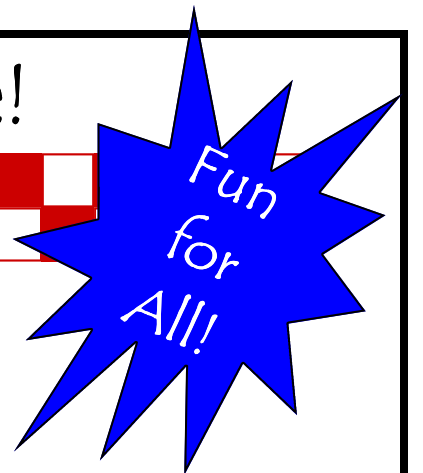
