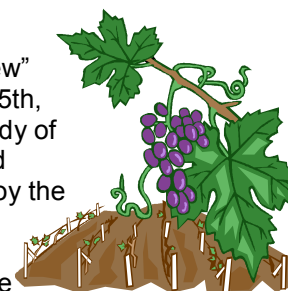
**Interested in the Catholic Faith?**
