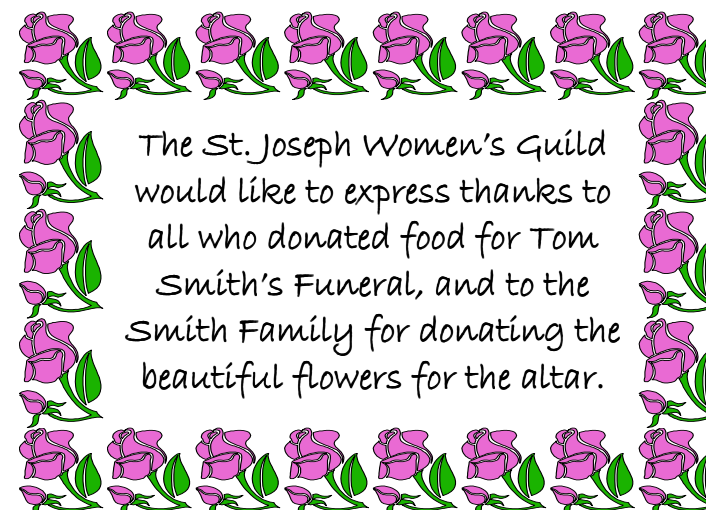

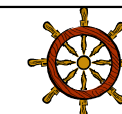
#### Graduation Mass and Breakfast
